

#### INVITATION FOR BIDS BY ENVIRONMENTAL ALERT

#### **BACKGROUND**

Empowering Health Centers in Uganda (PHCU) is a joint project developed by <u>Südwind</u> and <u>Environmental Alert</u> that aims at supporting health centers in hard to reach areas and refugee settlements in Uganda – within the Albertine rift – that are faced with energy access limitation, which compromise effective delivery of health services to some of the hardest hit communities by COVID 19.

Through installing small-scale solar solutions, the two refugee communities and two Ugandan communities are benefiting from better health services delivery. This is due to the more reliable energy for lighting, running computers, conducting laboratory tests, immunization among others. By installing new capacity as well as the necessary infrastructure for energy storage (Batteries, etc.) the Health Centers (HCs) have dramatically increased their operations thereby servicing 75 % more patients in the community. These include Kasonga H/C II in Kikuube District, Maisuka H/C III in Kibaale District, Mahango H/C III in Kasese Districts and Mpara H/C III in Kyegegwa District.

Environmental Alert through PHCU project is looking for capable suppliers of materials in three categories: Pharmaceuticals, hardware, and general merchandise. A potential supplier can bid for one, two or all the three categories basing on his/her capacity.
