



Environmental Alert (EA) and Südwind are implementing a joint project entitled, “emPower Health Care in Uganda Project” (PHCU). PHCU aims at supporting health centers in hard-to-reach areas and refugees’ settlements in Uganda – within the Albertine rift – that are faced with energy access limitation, which compromise effective delivery of health services to some of the hardest hit communities by COVID 19.

By installing small-scale solar solutions, the two target refugee communities and two Ugandan communities will benefit from better health services delivery. This will be due to the more reliable energy for lighting, heating, running computers, powering transportation between households with the health centres and from health centres with key health care referral system in the district, conducting laboratory tests, refrigeration of immunization drugs, among others. Through installing new capacity as well as the necessary infrastructure for energy storage (Batteries, etc.) the health Centres (HCs) will dramatically increase their operations thereby servicing 75 % more patients in the community.

However, it is also crucial to note that health service delivery in refugee settlements and hard-to-reach areas, is not only hindered by energy, but there other factors like limited medical materials like protective gears, gam boots and this was worsened by emergency of pandemic that require special care.

It’s against this background that the project intends to procure and disseminate sanitary and other protective gears to the two health centres ( Kasonga Health Centre II and Maisuka Health centre II) to enable /facilitate improved health service delivery.
